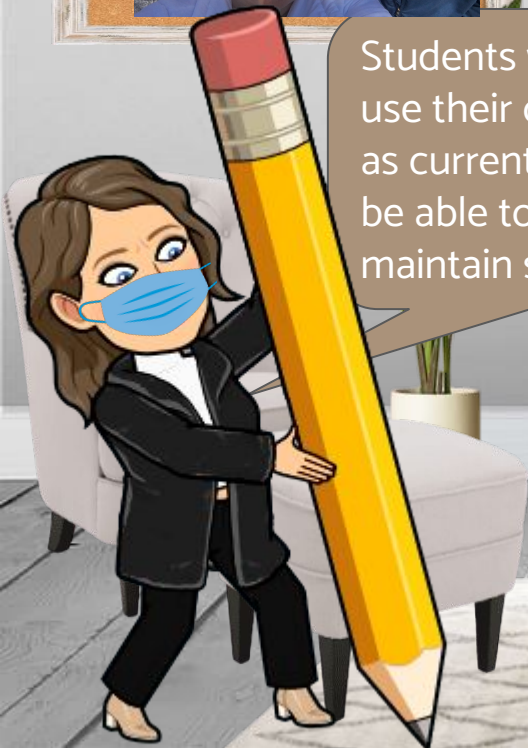


Hand sanitizing stations will be available upon entry into the building as well as in classrooms and common spaces.

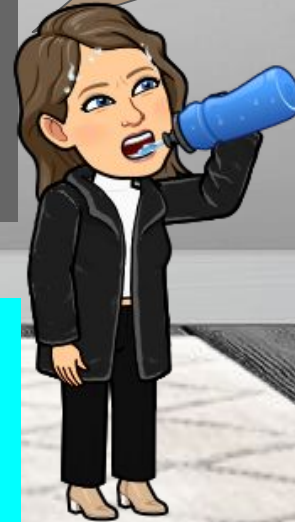

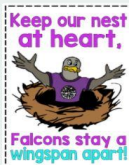

Wear your mask

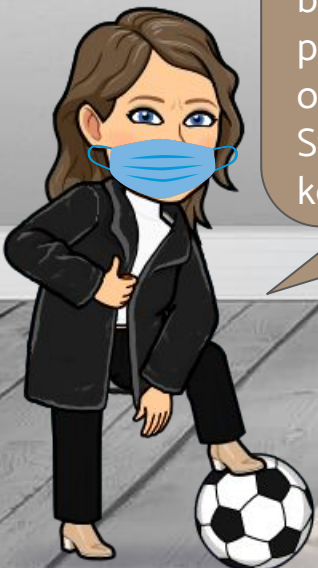


Follow all recess safety directions

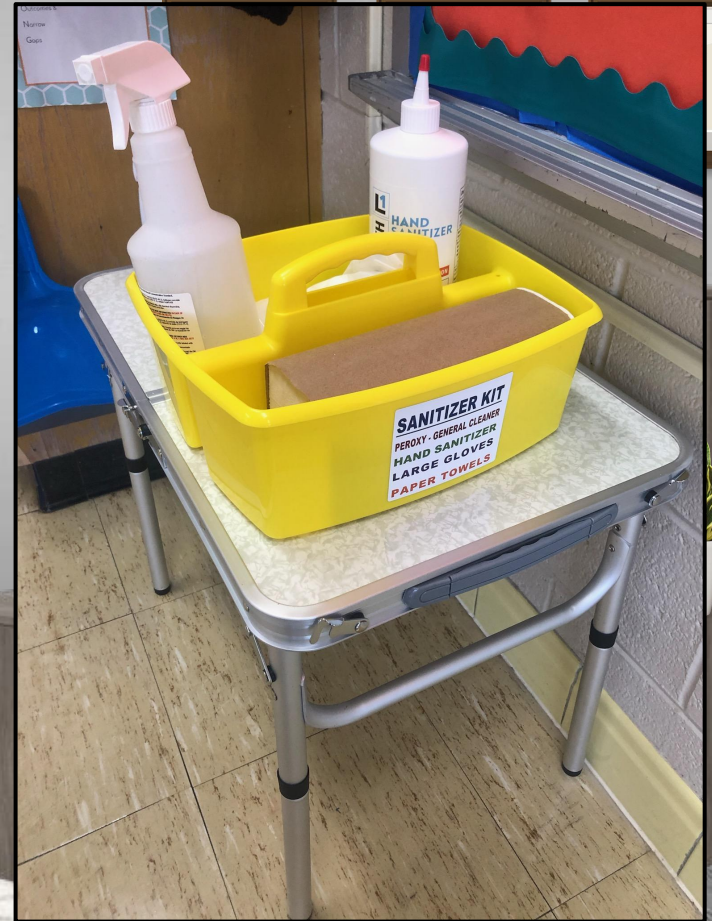

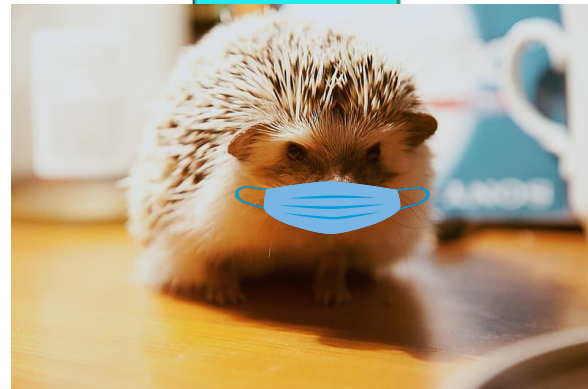
