
2025-2026 Direct Appeal

Due to some uncertainties and new costs not accounted for in the operating budget the PTO approved in September, <u>our direct appeal may be our primary fundraising opportunity this year</u>.

The PTO puts every dollar raised back into the community.

- Supports new staff to help build classroom libraries and we have one of the largest classes of new teachers this year!
- Celebrates and supports all staff through stipends, grants, celebrations and recognitions throughout the school year.
- Builds community through events and programming.
- Provides scholarships, and spirit wear and yearbooks for all students.
- Invests in the gardens and green spaces across the campus.

If you are in a position to give more, please consider donating for a family who cannot. VHE RESOURCE ROOM

The VHE Resource Room was created to help our community alleviate any financial stressors that they are facing. We want all of our students to have access to some basic needs so they can engage in academic, social and play activities at school. This is available to the entire VHE community.

Families can put in one request per month using *this* form. Requests will be accepted until the school year ends or supplies run out. This program is made possible by the generosity of our community. Please request only what you need so we can support as many families as possible. There are no requirements or questions asked to access the resource room. Once you have completed the form, please allow one week to receive the supplies.

Information is confidential and not shared. School Social Worker, Amy Robel, manages the requests and the resource room.

November is Homelessness Awareness Month.

Homelessness does not discriminate, it can affect anyone from all walks of life, including various ages, race, gender or background due to a wide range of causes like increasing rent/housing costs, job loss, illness, etc. Last year, MMSD identified over 1400 students that were experiencing homelessness. At VHE, we will wear **PURPLE** on **11/14** to increase awareness.
