Marzano, "Students who can identify what they are learning significantly outscore those who cannot." The act of posting the essential outcomes does not raise our students' achievement, it is the act of unpacking what they mean and referring to the goal several times within a lesson that is a high leverage practice. When students know what they are aiming for, they typically can hit any target!

Fire/Safety Drills

Please know that throughout the months we practice various drills that are not always announced. I will

Community Building at VHE: Assembly & Morning Meetings

This year staff are continuing with ways that support having spaces that promote significance, belonging, and community! This includes having our schedule include time for having a Morning Meeting- most grade levels have 30 minutes at the onset of the school day this year.

Responsive Classrooms are so important to developing our social and emotional needs. During this time we also include lessons on Social & Emotional Learning and Health. This includes 1)Daily Greeting 2)Morning Message 3)Activity 4)Share. Also, I have planned for monthly Good Character Assemblies that will typically be during the last week of the month. On Monday we welcomed all scholars and staff with the message that we are part of an amazing community & chosen to be a Hedgehog! In the future our 5th Grade Leaders will plan and facilitate these whole group opportunities!

From Van Hise Physical Education:

In this first month of school we have been practicing how to move our bodies safely around the gym. We have learned about locomotor movements. Locomotor movements take us from one place to another (skipping, galloping, jumping, walking, running...). We have also learned some recess games to play outside.

Many of you may have heard your kiddos talking about GAGA ball. Gaga ball is a striking game that is fast paced and gets students moving. Make sure you ask your child more about gaga ball!

A friendly reminder to send your child to school with an extra pair of gym shoes. I'm seeing many sandals/boots/clogs in the gym. I want all students to be able to move safely and good athletic shoes are the best in the gym.
